Affidavit of Mr. Sanjeev Thapar, Principal, Govt. Senior Secondary Model School, PAU, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4 has been filed in Court today.

The same is taken on record.

In the said affidavit, it has been averred that the petitioner has been deemed to be retired from service on 31.12.2015 on attaining the age of 60 years for all intents and purposes in view of the decision in Civil Writ Petition No.7233 of 2012-Bhupinder Singh Vs.State of Punjab. The petitioner has accordingly been paid the arrears of annual increments amounting to ₹ 18,117/- on 3.5.2016 and the pension case of the petitioner has been sent to the office of Accountant General, Punjab, Chandigarh for revision of retiral benefits after adding service rendered beyond the age of 58 years in “Qualifying Service” vide letter dated 26.4.2016 issued by the office of the answering respondent.

Counsel for the petitioner disputes the payment issue.

Resultantly the respondents are directed to ensure that payment is credited to the account of the petitioner within one month from today, if already not paid.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
