KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner retired as Sweeper from the office of respondent No.4 on 30.06.2016. The retiral benefits have not been released to him. He also claims interest thereon.

The short prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner is that respondent No.4 may be directed to decide the legal notice dated 16.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner.

In these circumstance, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to consider the legal notice dated 16.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and pass a speaking order within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order and if the retiral benefits are due to the petitioner, the same shall be released to him along with interest, as per Government instructions.
