Vide this common judgment, CWP No.23482 of 2014 (Mohit Saini & others Vs. Punjab and Haryana High Court and another), CWP No.710 of 2015 (Sher Mohammad Vs. Punjab and Haryana High Court and another) and CWP No.7411 of 2015 (Praveen Kumar Vs. Punjab and Haryana High Court and another) are being disposed of as common question of law and facts are involved in all the petitiones..

Learned counsel for respondents has informed that the matter has been considered by the Committee on 20.01.2016 and it has been recommended that the Restorers who have completed two years service on the said post up till December 2015, are eligible to appear for computer test for consideration for promotion as Clerks. It has been proposed that the result of the earlier test already held and test of the eligible Restorers, now to be held, will be declared on the same day so that the seniority of the Restorers who qualify the test and are eligible for promotion can be protected in terms of Rule 30 (ii) of the High Court Establishment (Appointment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1973.

In view of the above recommendations, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) seeks permission to withdraw these petitions.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the High Court shall conduct the test in due course.
