The petitioners, who are working on daily wages, seek regularization of their services in terms of the policy issued by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners No. 1, 2 and 3 were appointed in the year 1996, 1994 and 1999 respectively and they are stated to be continuing in the posts from the dates of their appointment. Learned counsel further contends that the services of petitioners No. 1 and 2 were terminated in the year 2005 while the services of petitioner No. 3 were terminated in the year 2006. However, vide the Awards of the Tribunal, they were directed to be re-instated with continuity in service. The petitioners have also served legal notice to the respondents for consideration of their case of regularization but the same have evoked

no response.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the legal notice dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the legal notice of the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
