ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents not to permit the candidates who do not have the minimum qualification of Haryana Teachers Eligibility Test (HTET) as prescribed in the advertisement issued by the respondents on 28.06.2015 to participate in the selection process. The petitioner is stated to have applied for the post of PGT (Punjabi) in pursuance to the afore-noted advertisement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner apprehends that ineligible candidates who do not possess the qualification of HTET may be called for interview by the respondents as is being done in the case of appointments to other posts.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petition appears to be premature at this stage as the petitioner is competing for the post of PGT (Punjabi) and she has not been able to point out any case wherein an ineligible candidate is being considered for the post

of PGT (Punjabi). Therefore, the petition cannot be entertained at this stage

being premature. It shall of course be open to the petitioner to approach this Court in case the respondents call ineligible candidates for interview for the post of PGT (Punjabi).

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
