G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner seeks correction in the date of birth in the school record maintained by the respondent-Board on the basis of birth certificate (Annexure P/1) issued by the Registrar, Births and Deaths, Municipal Corporation, Hoshiarpur.

In the written statement filed by the respondent-Board, it has been mentioned that without making an application along with the prescribed fee, the petitioner had directly approached this Court and therefore, the present writ petition is not maintainable.

The averments regarding submitting the representation (Annexure P/4) have been denied on the ground that there was no proof of dispatch or submission of the representation.

In such circumstances, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable. However, it is open to the petitioner to file a detailed representation along with prescribed fee to the respondent-Board. If the

petitioner files such representation, respondent no.2 shall consider the representation and take a decision within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.
