The sole conciliator i.e. the Additional Deputy Commissioner,
Gurgaon has given his report dated 20.10.2016 which is produced today in
court. The relevant portion of the report is as under:-

*“Both parties have agreed for assessment
of compensation to be paid to M/s Gawar
Construction ltd. by third party, preferably a
government body, within time period of 3 weeks.
There are 2 components of compensation
demanded by M/s Gawar Construction ltd.:-*

- a) Compensation for investment in physical
infrastructure.*
- b) Compensation for loss of business
opportunity and revenue.*

*For determining compensation for
investment in physical infrastructure, a neutral
body/authority can be deputed to assess quantum*

of work done at sites and thus calculate compensation. For compensation for loss of business opportunity and revenue, both parties should reach an agreement on appointing assessor or any proposition as directed by Hon'ble High Court.”

In view of the aforesaid, nothing survives in this petition and thus it is disposed of at this stage.
