JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioners, 32 in number possess the essential qualifications prescribed for the post of Masters/Mistresses. They also have passed their mandatory test PSTET-II for appointment to the post of Masters/Mistresses. They have competed for the 6060 posts of Masters/Mistresses advertised vide advertisement dated 14.12.2015/15.06.2016 by the Education Department (Secondary Education), Punjab.

Their grievance is that in the case of similarly situated candidates aspirant for appointment to the post of ETT teachers, the Education Department has increased the number of posts by issuance of corrigendum. However, similar treatment is being denied to them inspite of thousands of the posts in the cadre of Masters being available in the quota

of direct recruitment.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition to enable her clients to pursue their remedy before the appropriate authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
