Anupinder Singh Grewal, J. (Oral) :

The petitioners have challenged the order dated 18.10.2016/17.10.2016 (Annexure P-1), whereby they were relieved from the post of JBT Teachers (Guest Teachers). They have sought a further direction to the respondents to re-engage them as Guest Teachers.

In the reply filed by the respondents, it is stated that open counselling has been conducted by the respondents and prior information was issued to all the eligible candidates. Petitioners No. 2, 4, 5, 6 and 8 marked their presence and they have joined their respective schools after allocation by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the State states that petitioner No.1 has also joined the school allocated by respondent No.2. He further contends that petitioner No.7 has not yet joined the school, which was allocated to her and the case of petitioner No.3 has been accepted for Inter District adjustment.

At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 7 would also join in pursuance to the open counselling, if she is adjusted in a nearby school.

Learned counsel for the respondents contends that the school, which has been allocated to petitioner No. 7 in Village Rod, Tehsil Safidon, District Jind, is within 10 kms. from her previous place of posting.

Be that as it may. In view of the fact that the petitioners have been adjusted as guest teachers in various schools by the respondents, the petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
