RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

Dr. Sekhon, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, has informed the Court that pension and pensionary dues including gratuity, leave encashment etc. have been paid to the petitioner but with delay. So far as family pension is concerned, the matter is to be examined and will be resolved due to the complexity presented by the deceased Government servant leaving behind two wives. So far as delay in making the payment under the various Heads is concerned, those amount would earn interest @ 9% per annum and the amount be calculated and paid within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. As far as family pension case is concerned, a direction is issued to the respondents to take a final decision within two months and place the result of the exercise on the record of this disposed of matter for perusal of the Court.

With the above directions, the petition stands disposed of.
