At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has made a representation to respondent No.3 regarding induction of new members in violation of bye-laws of the Society. Thereafter, an adhoc Committee of the Society was constituted to look after the daily affairs of the Society. The representation filed by the petitioner dated 15.2.2016 (Annexure P-2) has not been decided so far. He further submits that petitioner would be satisfied in case the directions are issued by this Court to decide representation dated 15.2.2016 (Annexure P-2) within some stipulated period.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 15.2.2016 (Annexure P-2) and pass necessary orders in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of

receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
