The petitioner was appointed as PTI Teacher vide appointment letter dated 29.08.2012 (P-1) pursuant to her selection against the advertisement for such post issued by the Department of Education during the year 2006. The appointment of certain candidates, including the petitioner, got delayed due to pendency of certain writ petitions in this Court.

The prayer in the present petition is for notional fixation of the pay of the petitioner pursuant to the general instructions dated 18.01.2016 (P-3) issued in that regard.

It is contended that vide order dated 12.07.2016 (P-4) the

dated 18.01.2016 directed the notional fixation of the petitioner by granting deemed date of appointment from the date the candidates of same selection were appointed. However, the Headmaster of the Govt. Girls High School, Dayalpur where the petitioner is posted is not implementing the order.

Upon notice learned State Counsel assisted by Mr. Ajit Pal Singh, Maths Master, Govt. Girls High School, Dyalpur, District Kapurthala does not dispute either the instructions dated 18.01.2016 nor the passing of the order dated 12.07.2016 (P-4), however, prays for sometime to implement the order.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the District Education Officer, Kapurthala and Head Master, Govt Girls High School, Dayalpur to fix the notional pay of the petitioner as per her entitlement within a period of two weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order failing which they shall be liable to pay costs of Rs.10,000/- each to be paid to the petitioner and such facts r3ecorded in their respective ACRs.
