The petitioner has impugned the action of the respondents in not displaying the marks of unsuccessful candidates, even though the result of the written examination was declared. The petitioner has also sought a direction to the respondents to display the marks obtained by her as well as other candidates, who had appeared in the written examination.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State has filed reply in Court today, which is taken on record. A copy of the same has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is stated in the reply that the petitioner has secured 29.60 marks out of 75 marks as a General Category candidate while the marks obtained by the last candidate called for interview in this Category are 30.55. It is also stated that the marks of the petitioner along with other unsuccessful candidates have been uploaded on the website of the

respondent-Commission on 19.11.2016.

Therefore, as the petitioner has secured less marks than the cut off marks of the last candidate in the General Category, who has been called for interview and the marks of unsuccessful candidates have been displayed on website, I do not find any merit in the instant petition. In the result, the petition stands dismissed.
