1. Whether reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

Heard the submissions made on either side.

Sh. Ashok Kumar Saini, the 1st respondent herein, filed original application before the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench seeking a direction to the writ petitioner herein to issue integrity certificate which was withheld by them in spite of the approval granted by the Union Public Service Commission that the 1st respondent was eligible and suitable for issuance of integrity certificate.

After thoroughly advertent to the facts and circumstances of this case in the background of the rival submissions made, learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench directed the writ petitioners to

issue the integrity certificate in favour of 1st respondent within 15 days from the date of receipt of order passed by it.

Learned counsel appearing for the 1st respondent submitted that the 1st respondent had unfortunately died and as a result of which, nothing survives in the present writ petition.

The above submission has found favour with the counsel appearing for the writ petitioners as well as for the proforma respondents No.3 and 4. Therefore, we are of the considered view that nothing survives for determination in the present writ petition on account of the untimely demise of the 1st respondent. Therefore, the writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
