Petitioner claims that he is physically handicapped. His prayer is that he should be exempted from participating in transfer drive as per the Teachers Transfer Policy, 2016 dated 29.06.2016 (Annexure P-2). Petitioner has also filed representation dated 14.10.2016 (Annexure P-7).

In these circumstances, the present petition is considered to be pre-mature. Let the petitioner pursue his case before the authorities.

In view of the said circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representation dated 14.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner, in accordance with rules/law and pass an appropriate order, at the earliest, without being influenced by the fact that the petitioner had approached this Court.
