The petitioner seeks the relief of issuance of appointment letter to the post of Constable in the Backward Class Category in District Ferozepur.

The precise grievance of the petitioner is that the Backward Class Category candidates who had secured more marks than the last selected candidate in the General Category had not been shifted to the General Category and therefore, he does not fall within the zone of consideration and was at Sr.No.4 in the waiting list. It is his case that four candidates who had applied, had more marks than the General Category candidates and they should have been selected in the General Category and thus, the petitioner would be entitled for appointment.

The writ petition, though had been opposed by filing reply initially. But today, counsel for the State, on instructions from Shri Amit Kumar, Assistant Civil Suit Clerk, from the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur-respondent No.3, submits that the petitioner will be given favourable consideration, as prayed for and the necessary appointment letter shall be issued after verification of character and medical fitness

reports, on account of the re-computation of the result. It is submitted that the said exercise could not be done due to the pendency of the present writ petition.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the assurance given by the State Counsel, he has no objection if the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with the condition that respondents No.2 & 3 shall comply with the above conditions, within a period of 3 months from the receipt of a certified copy of the order.

Disposed of, in terms of the above undertaking.
