Present writ petition is directed against the order dated 01.10.2016 (Annexure P-11) and also communication dated 19.07.2016 (Annexure P-9).

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is a matter of record that impugned order dated 01.10.2016 (Annexure P-11) is an interim order, only fixing the date of hearing in the revision petition No.61 of 2016 filed by Sonapat Urban Cooperative Bank Limited. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not point out any difficulty being faced by the petitioner in approaching the revisional authority, who is already seized of the matter and the case is listed before the revisional authority today itself, in pointing out any illegality, including alleged non-maintainability of the revision petition. So far as the communication dated 19.07.2016 (Annexure P-9) is concerned, nothing has been pointed out as to how it is against the interest of the petitioner.

In view of the above, present writ petition has been found wholly misconceived, bereft of merit and without any substance, thus, it must fail. No case for interference has been made out.

Resultantly, with the abovesaid observations made, instant writ petition stands dismissed, however, with no order as to costs.
