The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents for re-designating him as Professor. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioner for re-designation is to be sent by respondent No.3 to respondents No.1. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that he has represented to respondents No.1 and 3 in this regard but no action has been taken thereon by the respondents and he shall be satisfied if this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider and decide his case for re-designating him as Professor with effect from the date of his eligibility for the same.

Issue notice to the respondents. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to furnish two sets of paper book to the learned counsel for the respondents during the course of the day.

Without making any observations on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to respondents No.1 and 3 to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in for re-designation as Professor in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
