Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court, by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that he does not intend to press the present writ petition for a writ in the nature of certiorari, for the time being. He further submits that when the genuine grievance of the petitioner was not being redressed, he finally approached the respondent authorities by way of self-contained representation dated 15.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner within a reasonable time by passing an appropriate order thereon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without

expressing any opinion on merits of the case, Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Karnal-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance raised by the petitioner vide his representation dated 15.11.2015 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same, keeping in view the observations made by this Court in its order dated 16.11.2015 passed in CWP No.19468 of 2015 (Annexure P-6), at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
