The petitioner has assailed the order dated 23.08.2016 (appended as Annexure P-7) along with the writ petition, whereby the petitioner has been blacklisted for a period of one year and also debarred from participating in any Govt. contract in any department throughout the State of Punjab and the earnest money has been forfeited without passing any speaking order. The grievance of the petitioner raised in the writ petition is Annexure P-7 which was passed without affording any opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and thus is against the principles of natural justice.

2. Written statement on behalf of respondent Nos. 3 & 4 filed today in Court is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to withdraw Annexure P-7. However, a prayer was made that liberty be granted to the respondents to pass a fresh order after affording an

opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of by setting aside the impugned order dated 23.08.2016 -Annexure P-7 with liberty to the respondents to pass a fresh speaking order in accordance with law after granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
