JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Sunita Kumari is working as a Lecturer in English since 31.5.2015 in Government Senior Secondary School, Raya, Amritsar. The Principal-respondent no.4 has illegally recorded certain adverse entries in the service book of the petitioner regarding observations recorded by the Inquiry Officer in a Preliminary/Fact Finding Enquiry which culminated into exoneration of the petitioner and no action ever was taken. It is asserted that against such illegal entries, a representation dated 25.07.2016 has been filed to DPI (Senior Secondary), Punjab which is stated to be pending.

Upon notice, a reply on behalf of State has been filed in Court today, wherein it is stated that the representation has since been decided vide order dated 07.11.2016 (**Annexure R-1**). The alleged illegal entries have since been ordered to be expunged, while proposing to initiate disciplinary proceedings against the Principal, who had unauthorizedly made such entries.

In response, learned State Counsel fairly states that nothing more requires to be adjudicated in the present case and as such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of above, present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
