Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been held to be a defaulter because of non payment of the amount of alleged late delivery of rice of the crop for the year 2012-13 but the element of interest has already been stayed by the arbitrator.

In view thereof, the petitioner shall be allotted paddy as per its entitlement. Hence, the present petition is hereby disposed of in view of order passed in LPA No.2043 of 2016 – M.B. Rice & General Mills v. Union of India and others. The petitioner is held entitled to allotment of paddy as per its entitlement.

With these observations, the present petition is hereby disposed of.
