Petitioners have filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears on account of revised Industrial Dearness Allowance.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for redressal of their grievance, petitioners had moved representations Annexure P-4 and Annexure P-6 before respondent No.3, but no action has been taken on the same so far.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.3 to dispose of the representations Annexure P-4 and Annexure P-6 moved by the petitioners, expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, petitioners are found entitled for the arrears claimed by them, the same be disbursed to them within one month thereafter.
