JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are retired Teachers/Employees of the Punjab Privately Managed Recognized Government Aided Schools, and are claiming the benefits of the revised pension as granted to the employees of the Punjab Government vide notification dated 17.08.2009 (Annexure P-10) in view of the recommendations of the 5th Pay Commission.

Learned State Counsel in the light of a short affidavit filed on behalf of the State, submits that subsequently a circular dated 02.12.2015 (Annexure R-1) has been issued, whereby, the demand of the retirees from the Privately Managed Aided Schools, including that of petitioner, has been accepted and they have been extended the benefit of the notification dated 17.08.2009 (Annexure P-10). However, the arrears have been directed to payable in four equal installments.

Thus, submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous.

None has put in appearance to dispute the aforesaid factual matters.

In view of the stand of the State and the reply, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.
