Mr. Thiara has returned with positive instructions that the petitioner's request has been treated as an appeal to be heard by the Executive Committee of the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC), which is the highest decision making body under the Sikh Gurdwara Act, 1925. The gesture is appreciated by the Court. The Court reposes great faith in the Committee that it would dispense justice and only justice to the petitioner in whatever manner the Executive Committee thinks fit in its wisdom.
