Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that this petition may be disposed of by issuing directions to the respondents to deliver the petitioner 5003 MT paddy to which he is entitled to.

Mr. Bakshi appearing on behalf of contesting respondent while referring to his reply submitted that indeed the petitioner is entitled to allotment of 5003 MT paddy for the Kharif Marketing Season 2016-17 but it would be after cut applied @ 9.42% to the quantity of paddy proposed to be allocated to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has not raised any objection in this regard.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to allot paddy to the petitioner to the extent of 5003 MT after applying cut @ 9.42%. In case the petitioner is entitled to the allotment of paddy over and above the allotment already made, the said allotment be made to him forthwith within a day or two.
