The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No.1 to 5 to extend to the petitioners the same relief which has been granted to the petitioners in CWP No.14927 of 2015 vide order dated 22nd July, 2016 (Annexure P-1) and a further prayer for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.5 & 6 has also been made.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation along with supporting documents. However, a prayer was made to issue a time bound direction to the respondents to decide the same expeditiously.

3. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, the writ petition is disposed of by observing that in case such a representation is filed by the petitioners within a period of one month from

today, the same shall be decided by respondent No.2 by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of next three months from its filing.
