1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing of the Show Cause Notice dated 02.08.2016 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.3 as the same is in complete violation of Article 14 & 19(1) (G) and against the settled tenets of the principles of natural justice.

2. It was not disputed that the petitioner has approached this Court without filing any reply to the show cause notice.

3. At this stage learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the authority concerned and submit reply to the aforesaid show cause notice.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, it shall however be open to the

petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him in
accordance with law.
