1. Petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allot the alternative SCF in an equally developed scheme of the Trust, in lieu of SCF No. 16 (measuring 169 Sq Yds) in Gian Singh Rarewala Market, Ludhiana with further prayer to compensate the petitioners appropriately as due to non action on the part of the respondents, the petitioners have not been able to use the site since its allotment and deposit of entire consideration amount.

2. After arguing for sometime learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising the grievance as raised in the writ petition. However, prayer is made that a time bound direction be issued to respondents to decide the same expeditiously by passing a speaking order.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. However, it will be open to the petitioners to file a representation within a month from today with supporting material. In case such a representation is filed, the same shall be decided by respondent No. 2 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.
