This petition is filed to challenge the order dated 20.7.2016, passed by respondent No.2, evicting the petitioner from the house owned by respondent No.3.

In brief, petitioner is the son of respondent No.3. His mother (respondent No.3) filed an application, under the provision of Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 [for short 'the Act'] for seeking eviction of the petitioner from her house.

In the said application, the petitioner did not appear despite service and was proceeded against *ex parte* and it was found by respondent No.2 found that the house in question belongs to respondent No.3 in which petitioner has been living unauthorisedly, therefore, he passed the order of his eviction. Except for challenging the order, no case has been made out by the petitioner as to how the house in question belongs to him. In the absence

can be found with the order passed by respondent No.2 in favour of respondent No.3.

In view thereof, I do not find any merit in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
