On 21.05.2014, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Counsel for the petitioners submits that relief has been granted to the extent that the petitioners have been allowed to appear in the final examination and the result has been declared and DMC has been given. Perusal of the status report filed today would go on to show that earlier, Dalbir Singh was arrested in another case and thereafter, he was arrested on 20.10.2014 in the concerned FIR. It has been averred

that out of 14 witnesses, 06 have been examined. The said accused was released on bail by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhajhar on 06.01.2015.

In view of the status report received, it is apparent that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of, as such.
