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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner retired from service on 31.12.2015, but he has not been paid pensionary benefits. The petitioner had already served a legal notice dated 1.4.2016 (Annexure-P-2) upon the respondents.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and if there is no impediment in the release of pensionary benefits, the same shall be released forthwith, and if some claim of the department is pending, pass a speaking order, denying a particular relief within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Needless to say that if there is delay in releasing the payment, the interest as per the Government instructions shall

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also be released.
