Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has already filed objections which are not being decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra. Learned counsel further states that direction may be issued to the Deputy Commissioner to decide the objections within a stipulated period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, the Deputy Commissioner may decide the objections filed by the petitioner himself, after calling the record, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order or he may refer the case to any other competent officer. The Deputy Commissioner is further directed to reconsider whether recovery can be effected for more than three years. The petitioner will be at liberty to avail the other remedies available to him in accordance with law.
