In this petition, the petitioner has questioned the award dated 26.09.2013 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No. 1-Presiding Officer, Labour Court, Ambala vide which the petitioner workman (respondent No. 2 herein) was directed to re-instate with continuity of service w.e.f. 24.12.2010 and 50% back wages within two months. In default the arrears of wages shall carry 9% interest.

On dated 01.03.2016 when the matter was listed, it was agreed by both the parties that petitioner(respondent No. 2 herein) would re-instate with 25% back wages and the same has been complied on 14.03.2016.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed off in aforesaid terms.

So far as grant of 50% back wages by the Labour Court, Ambala is concerned, it is modified to the extent of 25% back wages.

Disposed of.
