The prayer in the present petition is for quashing part of memo. dated 30.9.2015 (Annexure P-18), order dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P-19) and letter dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-20) to the extent that the petitioner has not been granted benefit of regularization from the date his juniors have been regularised vide order dated 24.5.2011 passed in CWP No. 10898 of 2002.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been regularized vide order dated 15.9.2016 and his pay has been re-fixed but the arrears of pay have not been released to him.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that services of the petitioner have been regularized and pay has also been re-fixed, this petition is disposed of with a

direction to the respondents to decide the issue of payment of arrears of pay within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
