ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to re-conduct the physical measurement test of the petitioner. The petitioner had applied for the post of Constable in pursuance to the advertisement issued by the respondents on 19.7.2015 (Annexure P1). Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that although the height of the petitioner is 171 cms which is above the minimum of 169 cms as prescribed in the advertisement, the petitioner has been erroneously held to be ineligible for the post of Constable. He has also drawn my attention to the representation sent to the respondents on 24.10.2016 (Annexure P4) to the respondents, which has failed to evoke any response.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to furnish three sets of paper book to Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana in the course of the day.

In the facts and circumstances, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction to the respondents to consider the representation

of the petitioner and re-measure the height of the petitioner within a period of one week. In case the height of the petitioner is found to be of the prescribed standard, then the petitioner would be considered for appointment to the post of Constable, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
