The challenge in the present writ petition is to the award of the Land Acquisition Tribunal dated 21.11.2006(Annexure P-1) whereby the amount of compensation of Rs.13,32,000/- per acre was awarded.

Another award passed by the Land Acquisition Tribunal on 10.02.2007 in similar circumstances has since been modified by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.6590 of 2007 titled Gian Singh v. The Kapurthala Improvement Trust, Kapurthala and others, decided on 13.10.2014, whereby compensation of Rs.20,00,000/- per

acre has been awarded.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to a judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court reported as Ajay Pal v. State of Haryana, 2015(2) R.C.R (Civil) 439, to contend that the petitioner is entitled to the same compensation as has been awarded in the writ petitions filed by the other set of land-owners.

Keeping in view the aforesaid judgment and the fact that this Court has awarded Rs.20,00,000/- per acre in Gian Singh's case (supra), the writ petition is allowed in the same terms as in Gian Singh's case (supra).
