Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that a revised plan has been prepared by respondent nos. 2 and 3 for shifting of Old Sabzi Mandi, Faridabad, to the New Fruits and Vegetables Market, Faridabad. In that market, a place has been earmarked for re-allocating the members of the petitioner association, who are carrying on their business of selling the fruits and vegetables in retail, though not licensee as such in the sabzi mandi.

Learned counsel for respondent nos. 2 and 3 while not disputing the fact that the revised plan has been prepared for construction of New Fruits and Vegetables Market at Faridabad in which a space has been earmarked for the retailers to carry on their business. The Board will construct a tin shed at the place for which the tenders have been invited. After the work is completed, the eligible retailers, who are already carrying on business in the Old Sabzi Mandi will be allotted space.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the stand taken by respondent nos. 2 and 3, the present petition may be disposed of in terms thereof.

Ordered accordingly.
