The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and pass appropriate order keeping in view the order dated 18.06.2001 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2- Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, Gurdaspur.

Firstly, the implementation of order dated 18.06.2001 (Annexure P-1) is being sought after about 15 years of passing. The said order has already been set aside by the Financial Commissioner holding that held revenue authorities have no jurisdiction to conduct or correct *khasra girdawari* once *jamabandhi* has been prepared.

At this stage, after arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy in accordance with

law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
