Issue notice to respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Two sets of paper book have been supplied to learned State counsel.

The petitioners, who are working as Clerks in Excise and Taxation Department, Haryana, have sought direction to the respondents to promote them as Assistants from the dates their juniors have been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that although the cases of similarly situated persons had been cleared for promotion yet the petitioners have not been promoted on the premise that there is dispute relating to their date of regularization, which has already been resolved by the respondents in the cases of others, while no action has been taken qua the petitioners. He has also drawn my attention to the representations

(Annexure P-7) in this regard, which have failed to evoke any response so far. Learned counsel states that he would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with direction to respondents to consider and decide the representations of the petitioners in a time bound manner.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to respondents to consider and decide the representations of the petitioners (Annexure P-7), in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
