Learned counsel for the respondents, at the very outset, pointed out that since during the pendency of the present writ petition, election came to be concluded on 12.01.2014, nothing is left to be decided in the present writ petition which has already been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but the petitioner may be granted liberty to pursue his other remedy including to challenge the validity of result of election before the appropriate authority in accordance with law.
