Counsel for the appellant states that she has instructions from the appellant to state that the appellant-husband does not press the appeal as regards the custody and guardianship of the minor but the interim arrangements regarding visitation rights should continue. Counsel for the appellant further states that it should, however, be directed that in case the minor changes his school, the principal should intimate the appellant.

We have heard counsel for the appellant and in view of her statement made on instructions, affirm order dated 02.12.2010, passed by the Guardian Judge-cum-Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rupnagar. The visitation rights, however, shall continue in accordance with interim order dated 15.07.2014. In case the minor is withdrawn from DAV Centenary Public School, L-Block, Shastri
