Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when respondent No.8 was not producing the record of the petitioner-Society before the competent authority i.e. Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Kapurthala-respondent No.6, official communications (Annexures P-7, P-8 and P-9) have been issued by respondent No.6 to respondent No.4 for taking immediate action against respondent No.8, however, the matter is still pending and no action has been taken either by respondent No.4 or by respondent No.7. He further submits that petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to take the appropriate action, at an early date.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner at some length and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala-respondent No.4 to look into the matter, consider the repeated official communications issued to him by Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Kapurthala-respondent No.6, vide Annexures P-7 to P-9 and take an appropriate action at an early date, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant writ petition stands disposed of.
