Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an appropriate order dated 5.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) was passed by the Director Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Punjab-respondent No.2, but the same is not being implemented by the field authorities of the respondent-Department.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedies with the respondent authorities.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
