1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a direction to the respondents to take over the petitioner-colonies/projects namely Shiwalik Avenue, Shiwalik Avenue-I, Shiwalik Avenue-II, Shiwalik Avenue-III and Shiwalik Avenue-IV, in Sector 125, Kharar, Greater Mohali and to provide itself or through developers all the basic amenities and development works in the above colonies under the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that inadvertently, certain facts could not be incorporated in the present writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer has been made that he may be allowed to

withdraw the present petition, with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action by furnishing complete and better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
