The petitioner has filed this writ petition for quashing the letter dated 05.03.2012 (Annexure P-8), whereby 5% interest instead of 18%, has been allowed on the payment of financial assistance.

The petitioner has earlier approached this Court by filing CWP No.22442 of 2011 which was disposed of vide order dated 13.12.2011 with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 26.09.2011, seeking benefit of the compassionate assistance which was admissible to the petitioner under the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of

Deceased Employees Rules, 2005, which had been adopted by DHBVN/UHBVN w.e.f.18.11.2005 (Annexure P-3).

In compliance to the order dated 05.03.2012 (Annexure P-8), passed by this Cour, Rs.5,00,000/- in respect of compassionate assistance was allowed to be given to the petitioner along with 5% interest on delayed payment. The payment of interest has been paid as per Sub-Rule 6(4) of Rules, 2005. Hence, the directions issued by this Court had been carried out by the department-DHBVN.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered opinion that there is no infirmity in the order dated 05.03.2012 (Annexure P-8).

The writ petition is dismissed, accordingly.
