S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

The petitioners seek the allotment of a plot which according to them was re-allotted by a letter dated 22.10.2012. The respondents had refused to allot the plot to them contending that no approval for allotment of an alternative plot as mentioned in the said letter dated 22.10.2012, had been granted by the head office. The respondents in fact state that an FIR No.176 dated 06.05.2013, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Model Town, Rewari has been lodged in this regard. The petitioners' entitlement to a plot has not been denied. The petitioners are transferees from the original allottee. However, the letter dated 22.10.2012, was pursuant to the petitioners' request for the allotment of an alternate plot.

2. The entire proceedings pertaining to the abovesaid FIR and to the letter dated 22.10.2012, may take a very long time. The petitioners are willing to accept any other alternative plot.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the petitioners' application for allotment of any other plot in accordance with law and including the relevant policy. The respondents are requested to comply with this order by 31.07.2016.
