RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

1. The petitioner has served a legal notice for demand of justice on the respondents praying that he may be allowed the benefit of proficiency step up increments to which end he has cited a number of judgments in the notice dated May 16, 2015 (Annex P-12). The same has not been decided. The prayer is for a direction to expedite decision making by the competent authority which prayer is found justified.

2. Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, a direction is issued to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. If petitioner makes a request for personal hearing, the same shall be granted. If the order is adverse to the petitioner, it shall be a speaking one.

3. With the above observations, the petition stands disposed of.
