The claim of the petitioners seeking regularization of their services as Multi Purpose Health Workers (Malaria Eradication Scheme) has been rejected by the respondents on the ground that some of these posts have been abolished whereas the remaining posts are under diminishing cadre as per the order of the Government dated 18.08.2004.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the post against which the petitioners are seeking regularization of their services was declared to be under diminishing cadre as per the order dated 18.08.2004, however, recently the Government has restored the posts of Field Workers/Health Assistants.

There is no document on the record to substantiate the same.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action after placing on record the documents in support of the aforemade assertion.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
