1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus for directions to respondents to pay compensation to the petitioner for the illegal construction of a road and sewerage on the land of the petitioner at the current prevalent market rates.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner for some time, when the Court was not inclined to entertain the writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to file civil suit or to take recourse to any other remedy as may be available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
